Odour measurement and control is increasingly important in the water industry. Odour levels are sometimes being specified in planning consents for sewage treatment works and odour issues are arising as new housing is built near existing works. The problem is that odour is an inexact measurement, with issues around surrogates, interferants, sampling and measurement techniques. This joint SWIG / SOSG Workshop will inform planners and operational management of the current state of the art both in Scotland, where a statutory code of practice on odour control has been introduced, and in the rest of the UK.
